**COVID-19 – Changes to guidance:**

From Thursday 24 February, the Government has removed the legal requirement to self-isolate following a positive test. Adults and children who test positive will continue to be advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least 5 full days, and then continue to follow the guidance until they have received 2 negative test results on consecutive days.

Lateral flow test kits:

Following the updated Government guidance, staff and students in secondary schools are no longer required to undertake twice weekly testing, therefore no more test kits will be given to students. 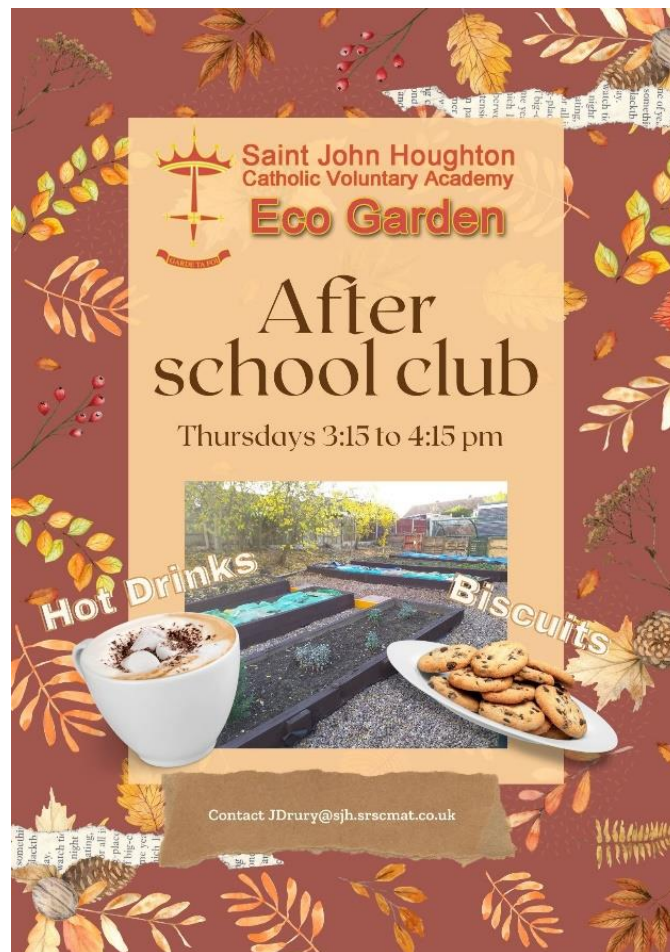
