COVID-19 – Changes to guidance from 1 April 2022:

- adults with the symptoms of a respiratory infection, and who have a high temperature or feel unwell, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature
- children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay
 at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or
 childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to
 attend
- adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days

UKMT Junior Maths Challenge:

On the 27th April, almost 100 of our most able year 7 and 8 Mathematicians took part in the Junior Maths Challenge. The problems on the Junior Mathematical Challenge are designed to make students think. Most are accessible, yet still challenge those with more experience.

To recognize the highest performers in the Challenge, the top-scoring 50% of participants are awarded Bronze, Silver and Gold certificates in the ratio 3:2:1. Students that are 'Best in

Year' or 'Best in School' will also receive a badge to denote this on their certificates. Students not amongst the high scorers will receive a Certificate of Participation.
