Do you want to meet up with friends, get to the gym or to a part time job for as little as £1.50? If so, the b\_line card is for you!

b\_line is a travel discount card for any young person aged 11 to 18 living in Derbyshire. It allows travel on buses in Derby and Derbyshire for just £1.50\*, and you can also travel to nearby towns and cities such as Burton on Trent, Manchester, Sheffield, and Nottingham, if the journey is direct and starts or finishes in Derbyshire. Sounds great right!?

Getting the bus means you're not relying on a lift from friends and family, will be cheaper than taxis; and it will get you further much further than walking or cycling.

To travel for £1.50, just show your b\_line card to the driver or tap the smartcard reader when you board the bus.

Apply for your b\_line card for free at blinecard.co.uk. Once you application is received you should receive your card in 7-10 working days.

#### **CERN trip:**

On the 23 October 2023, 33 students and 4 staff from Saint John Houghton had the adventure of a lifetime by travelling to Geneva, Switzerland as part of a science trip with the intention of going to CERN.

On the first day we saw the sights of Geneva; we visited the natural science museum to look at the species of animals from around the world, and spent the afternoon at Saint Pierre's Cathedral. Here some students took time out to reflect while others took the opportunity to climb the towers and see the wonderful views across Geneva lake and to look at the mountains. The students were fascinated.

The second day was our big day – we went to CERN! During the summer of 2023 CERN has moved all of their public interactions into a new building so we had the morning as free time looking around all the new exhibits. These were interactive and the students thoroughly enjoyed playing table tennis with protons, using magnets and working as a group to make their ball move around the circle and using the VR headsets to explore. They also learnt just how large the underground parts of CERN are, their favourite part was trying to get two protons to collide to make a Higgs boson. It was a brilliant morning! We then had lunch at CERN before being given a tour of a number of the CERN sites; we even crossed the border into France to see Alice! We all had a brilliant time! We then went for a group meal out together where the students couldn't stop talking about what they'd done that day.

Our final day was spent on Geneva lake. We had a boat trip on the lake to see various sites including the Jet d'Eau and many other sites. The students enjoyed having a bit of chill time where they just had to listen. One student sat drawing what she could see around the lake, what a lovely relaxing way to end our trip. We all had a brilliant time (despite the weather) and all of the students said how much they loved being able to go to CERN and in particular being some of the first people to see inside the new public buildings! **Miss Turgoose**



#### **Good Food Show NEC:**


It was great to have the opportunity to take Year 10 and 11 GCSE Food and Nutrition students to the BBC Good food show in Birmingham.

Here at SJH many staff use the App, 'Pray as you go.' We are delighted to see some of our students have started this good routine. Why not join us and let Rachel know how you get on.




