


World of weather....

Year 10 & 11 have all recently started their weather and climate topics, which couldn't be more fitting given the extremely changeable conditions we have recently been experiencing across the UK. Below is a snapshot of what they have been learning about air pressure and weather systems that affect the UK.

Did you know....(Statistics from metoffice.co.uk)


- Temperatures for November were near average overall.
- Despite the wet first half of the month, rainfall totals were near average across much of England, Wales and eastern Scotland, although it was wetter than average for some southern counties.
- Overall, the UK received slightly above-average sunshine hours (112%), but with a variable
 pattern: west parts of Wales and south-west England (for example) were notably dull whereas
 for the bulk of the rest of England this was a fairly sunny month.







In Year 8 students have just recently completed a topic all about rivers and flooding. They were studying the impacts of flooding in lesson and real time when the school had to close early due to the adverse weather conditions and now have a very real appreciation for the challenges of changing our landscapes and the links this has to flooding. Sadly, we know some members of our school community were directly affected by the flooding and a thoughts and prayers are with them as they deal with the ongoing issues.








