
## New from the Maths Department

### Year 7

Year 7 have had a been working incredibly hard learning new concepts in Maths. They have studied their "Introduction to Algebra" topic; learning how to simplify like terms, substitute into algebraic expressions as well as expanding and factorising single brackets. They then completed a unit of work on Fractions and are now beginning their "Introduction to Probability" topic. All students at SJH support their work in school with using Sparx Maths for homework. A big shout out to 7M2 who gained the highest average XP for their Sparx Maths in the school last week!

### <u>Year 8</u>

Year 8 have had a challenging term studying Sequencing and linear graphing. This involved looking at various types of sequences including Fibonacci, plotting coordinates in 4 quadrants and drawing graphs in the form y=mx+c. They are now continuing their studies with the Transformation topic, this involves, rotation, reflection, translation and enlargement. Here is an example of the work they have been doing.



#### <u>Years 9 & 10</u>

On the 31<sup>st</sup> January some of our most able students competed in the UKMT Intermediate Maths Challenge. This is a 60 minute, 25 multiple choice Challenge. It encourages mathematical reasoning, precision of thought and fluency to make students think. The problems on the Intermediate Maths Challenge are designed to make students think.

### <u>Year 11</u>

Year 11 are preparing to sit their mock exams. They are working incredibly hard, both in lessons and at home. They are given past papers to complete and encouraged to go through any questions they find more challenging with their Maths teacher, during after school revision or with Mrs Ellis on a Tuesday lunchtime in M2. They also have a revision check list with every Sparx video on there to help them with their preparation for their Exams.
