Scientific Thinking Challenge

A group of year 10 students were entered into the National Scientific Thinking Challenge. This challenge involved over 15,000 students from 266 schools in 10 countries. The challenge involved logical scientific questions with multiple choice answers and the students having to use their own knowledge (not something that



could be revised for) to be able to answer the questions - the Saint John Houghton students who were involved did us proud and performed brilliantly!
