## Important Science Information regarding false nails:

The synthetic material used to create acrylic nails readily ignites when exposed to a flame and can be difficult to extinguish, burning completely until the flame source is removed. Experts recommend caution when wearing acrylics, especially near open flames or heat sources. Therefore, any student wearing acrylic nails will not be allowed to complete any science practical using a Bunsen burner or any other naked flame to reduce the risk of serious injury.

To support school can you please check that students do not come to school wearing false nails as they will be missing out on important learning. Practical science is worth at least 40% of the GCSE exam mark so is crucial for a full science education.
