#### **Derbyshire County Council Household Support Fund:**

As part of the Government's Household Support Fund Scheme, Derbyshire County Council is distributing funding to households struggling to pay for food, energy, and essential living costs.



As part of the scheme, the Council will again be distributing grocery vouchers. Information about who is eligible for the vouchers is available on the website and distribution will start in **mid-January 26**. They will update the website when all vouchers have been distributed and provide details of what parents and carers should do if they have not received their voucher.

#### **TERM TIME ABSENCES:**

#### Circumstances allowed: Not Considered "Exceptional circumstances": • Taking part in a regulated

- · Family traditions of holidays at a certain time of year
- Going away for birthdays, including the students birthday
- Flight delays unless evidence supplied
- Illness after a school holiday or trip

#### ILLNESS:

#### Unauthorised attendance:

All absences will be marked as unauthorised on day 4 and onwards unless medical advice is sought/given. Arriving after the register has closed will affect students attendance. Medical appointments without evidence are also unauthorised.



#### Reasons that will be unauthorised:

- Period pains / cramps unless under medical care with evidence
  - Common colds
  - Headaches unless under medical care with evidence
    - Headlice

- Missed bus
- Family or own birthdays
- "Unwell" you must give an explanation
  - Oversleeping
- Parent too unwell / unable to bring student to school



Please try and make medical appointments out of school time, and daily contact is required for absences if more than 1 day is required.

If no contact is made, absences will be marked as unauthorised. Is my child too ill for school? - NHS (www.nhs.uk)

PLEASE BE AWARE: due to the advice of the local authority we have to send a letter to each person with parental responsibility regarding attendance, and not a joint letter.

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

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
